This Memorandum of Understanding documents that LATE SOW. SHESHABAI SITARAM MUNDHE ARTS COLLEGE, GANGAKHED and MAHATMA PHULE MAHAVIDYALAYA, KINGAON ; Library agrees to participate in the Collaborative Book Circulation Programme. In addition the Library will serve as a Center of Excellence (COE) - with regard to the collection.

I Purpose

The CBCP seeks to provide useful books to faculty of both colleges and other who need to use the collection. The increasing cost of managing, preserving, and providing access to large collections of books.

II Background

Both colleges are affiliated to Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University, Nanded and working in same city. Libraries accept the responsibility for receiving and providing all publications, coordinating circulation activities, faculties' communication among two libraries. All publications circulated through the CBCP are sent via librarian of both libraries. Faculties retained material for one academic year if they not do this they are able to charge fine.

III Scope

The both Libraries are members of CBCP and actively engage in cooperative collection circulation for the faculties in both colleges.

As a group, participating CBCP libraries agree to undertake the following activities:

- a) Operate the accounts of faculties with their borrower's card.

IV Applicable Administration

The consisting libraries set the conditions for the operation of the Program as administered by the librarian of both libraries. The CBCP functions within the scope of this structure.

The CBCP is governed by a librarian and library staff of participating libraries. The staff meets regularly by conference call to provide oversight, advice, and feedback on the workings of the project. To support implementation of the CBCP, Principal of the colleges meets annually to address standards, database design, metrics, and processing.



V Terms of Agreement

Librarians of both college libraries responsible for the following:

- 1) Inventory holdings and ensuring accurate circulation records for the extant collection at each faculty.
- 2) Create master lists of all titles in the relevant.
- 3) Fill identified gaps in collections.
- 4) Facilitate access to book titles through Inter-Library Loan.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

1. BACKGROUND

UGC has decided that "Every institution shall get National Accreditation and Assessment Council (NAAC) accreditation with a minimum score of 2.5 by 2022". In order to achieve this objective, UGC has decided to introduce a new initiative for mentoring the Non-Accredited Institutions, so that every institution can get accreditation by 2022.

In view of above a scheme has been designed which provides for Mentoring of Higher Education Institutions by a well performing accredited institution so as to enable them to upgrade their academic performance and get accredited.

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this the 16th day of September - Two Thousand and Nineteen (16/09/2019), by and between M.S.P. Mandals Shri Shivaji College, Parbhani, the First Party, represented herein by its Principal (hereinafter referred as 'First Party, the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors - in-office, administrators and assigns).

AND

Late Sow. Sheshabai Mundhe College, Gangakhed ,

The Second Party and represented herein by its Principal, (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors - in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and (First Party and Second Party are hereinafter individually referred to as 'Party').

WHEREAS:

First Party is recognized as a Mentor Institution by University Grants Commission.

Second Party is a recognized higher education institute who is interested to go for NAAC
First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provided each of them with enhanced opportunities.



The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Accreditation.

Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

Now therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this MOU, the parties here to agree as follows:

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

- i. Both the parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings.
- ii. The Second party will make its stakeholders available for being benefitted by the guidance of the second party.
- iii. It will be necessary on part of the Second party to make necessary infrastructural arrangements and provide secretarial support to the First party.
- iv. The First party will take care of amount being spent on TA & honorarium for conducting workshops, seminars and meetings held at premises of the second party as per the UGC guidelines.
- v. Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- vi. First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the Second Party.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

- i. Mentoring will facilitate the following:
 - Training of Faculty and Staff for proper processes, documentation, presentation
 - Sharing of knowledge, information and resources,
 - Opportunities for research collaboration and faculty development
 - Guidance and encouragement to institutions to adopt best practices.
- ii. Mentee Benefits:
 - Brings about enhancement in the overall Quality of the Mentee Institution
 - Enhances the profile of institutions as a result of improved quality of research, teaching and learning methodologies.



- Receives support in the Professional Development of Academics
- Increased exposure and speedier adaptation to best practices
- Advantage point in NIRF ranking and NAAC Accreditation

iii. **Mentor Benefits:**

- Additional learning acquired from experience
- Intellectual challenge of working in different environment
- Opportunities for increased collaboration
- Satisfaction of helping other and see them succeed

CLAUSE 3: VALIDITY

- This Agreement will be valid for minimum one year and maximum for years.
- Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon complementation of one year have to give 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, parties have to discharge their obligations.
